SYNOPSIS


Set over Labor Day Weekend in coastal New England, a middle-aged playwright invites longtime friend, legendary TV diva, Charlotte Christian, and occasionally-working actor friend, Jay Mulch, to read his latest dramatic effort, "The Extinction of Fireflies", a mythological comedy based on the epic romance of Roman Emperor Hadrian and his teenage lover Antinous. But when Jay brings along his new (and younger) lover Callisto, the feedback is spectacular. Starring Michael Urie, Tracie Bennett, Drew Droege, and Kario Marcel.











WRITER-DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT



James is the 2019 Cannes Lions Silver Award winner for his cocreation and direction of the immersive theatre piece As Much As I Can at the Public Theater in NYC, and Grand Prize recipient at the Rhode Island Film Festival for his teleplay, The Gods of **Newport**. James is the co-creator/ executive producer of the upcoming Hallmark Channel series Gilded Age Newport Mysteries. At Warner Bros, James executive produced: A Fearful **Joy: The Mother Teresa Story** (ABC miniseries). A Broadway World award winner, James is a Columbia University graduate who lives in Los Angeles and NYCand his beloved home in Westerly, RI.

I made this film during the 2020 global pandemic under my production company's **When All The World's A Stage** banner (https://whenalltheworldsastage.com). **When All The World's A Stage** is dedicated to producing screen adaptations of material originally written for the stage. "**The Extinction of Fireflies**" is our premiere film under this banner.

In light of the uncertain future of live theatre, I am keen to explore new ways to use the digital space in service of those stories traditionally told in the theatrical one. "The Extinction of Fireflies" explores a new format: dialogue driven, shot in a way that implies and breaks the fourth wall, with cinematography, production, and lighting design informed by the intersectionality of conventional theatre naturalism and realism.

"The Extinction of Fireflies" is the second play in a trilogy of plays that I began with "Jimmy and Carolyn", now in preproduction and set for an October 2021 start date with Mary Beth Peil and Gregory Harrison in the titular roles. These two plays and a third, "Ode To A Renegade", explore the generational issues and themes that are currently (and uniquely) manifesting in the lives of gay men of the pre- and post-AIDS cohorts.

This film is dedicated to all the fireflies extinguished by AIDS and by the corona virus.



PRODUCER'S STATEMENT



"Let's make a film!"

These were the words that James said to me about three months into the pandemic. Having come from the world of professional theatre, the entire life we knew had come to a screeching halt, and there was no end in sight. "We don't know when theatre will be back, so what does theatre look like now that there is no theatre?" When there is no more theatre in traditional houses and all the world becomes a stage, what does that look like?

James had written two plays of a trilogy, both of which had the elements we wanted and a story that had yearned to be told. So, we began our first film collaboration. The idea was to bring our small cast in and rehearse for a couple of weeks as you would do for a play. After these rehearsals and then camera rehearsals on set (James's house!) Where we would shoot large chunks of the film in order to have the continuity of a live production—which is how we shot an entire full length feature in five days.

Production began in September in Shelter Harbor, Rhode Island. The actors were housed up the street from the film location in a former artist's enclave. Due to Covid restrictions, and to ensure the utmost safety of everyone involved, we became our own little creative pod.

It is my pleasure to introduce you to our film and we truly hope you enjoy "The Extinction of Fireflies".

MICHAEL URIE was seen last season in back to back New York theatre productions beginning with the Public Theater's revival of Tony Kushner's A Bright Room Called Day and followed by the Broadway premiere of Bess Wohl's Grand Horizons. Prior to that, he starred in the Tony Award nominated Broadway revival of Harvey Fierstein Torch Song, following his critically acclaimed performance in the off-Broadway production at Second Stage, earning Lucille Lortel Award and Drama League Award nominations. Michael originated the role of Alex More in Jonathan Tolins' Buyer & Cellar Off-Broadway, on tour, and in London, for which he received the Drama Desk Award, Clarence Derwent Award, the Lucille Lortel Award, LA Drama Critics Award and nominations for the Drama League and Outer Critics Circle Awards.

DREW DROEGE as James


DREW DROEGE is best known for his online parody videos of downtown indie darling Chloë Sevigny, featured in Entertainment Weekly, The Advocate, TimeOut New York, OUT magazine's Out 100, Marc Jacobs' 2016 Spring campaign, and HBO's Wigstock documentary, "Wig".

He played Mr. Dennis, the drama teacher, on Paramount Network's "Heathers" and has recurred on "Search Party", "Bob's Burgers", "Drunk History", "Gloop World", "IdiotSitter", "Key and Peele", "Comedy Bang! Bang!", and Logo's "Cocktails And Classics". Other TV credits include "Bless The Harts", "Q-Force", "Now Apocalypse", "Teachers", "Transparent," "Life In Pieces", "Nobodies", "Bajillion Dollar Properties", "2 Broke Girls," "House Of Lies," "Kroll Show," "New Girl," "Happy Endings," and "How I Met Your Mother". He is also the voice of Pia, one of the villains, on the reboot of the popular video game, "Battletoads". He's appeared in the films "El Tonto", "The Never List", "Ideal Home", "The 4th", "The Circle", "Scouts Guide to the Zombie Apocalypse", "You're Killing Me", and "Eating Out: Drama Camp". He received the Outstanding Performance award at Outfest Los Angeles in 2018 for the BroadwayHD capture of "Bright Colors And Bold Patterns" (available to watch on broadwayhd.com).

He is an alum of The Groundlings and Upright Citizens Brigade theaters in Los Angeles, where he performs regularly. Other LA theatre credits include Charles Busch's "Die, Mommie, Die!", Justin Sayre's "Ravenswood Manor", Matt Wilkas & Mark Setlock's "Born To Win", Julie Brown's "The Homecoming Queen's Got A Musical", long-running drag "The Golden Girlz", and musical parodies of "Troop Beverly Hills" and "The Devil Wears Prada".
